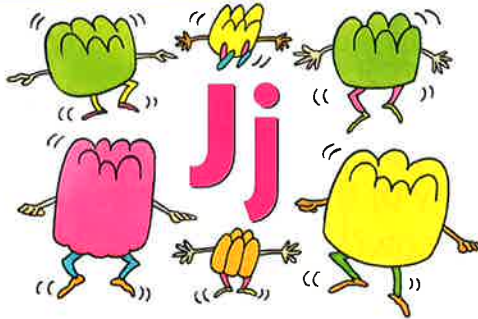


J words

jacket jackets

A **jacket** is a short coat.

jam jams

1 **Jam** is a sweet food. It is made from fruit and sugar.

I had strawberry jam on my toast.

2 There is also a **jam** when it is so crowded that nothing can move.

The car was stuck in a traffic jam.

January

January is the first month of the year. It has 31 days.

jar jars

A **jar** is a glass container with a wide top. It is used for storing food, such as jam.



jaw jaws

Your **jaw** is one of the bones that hold your teeth.

jeans

Jeans are trousers made from a strong cotton material. They are often blue. (See page 176.)

jelly jellies

Jelly is a soft, sweet food that you can see through.

jet jets

1 A **jet** is an aeroplane that can fly very fast and very high.

2 A **jet** is also a narrow stream of something.

A jet of water shot out through the hole in the pipe.

jewel jewels

A **jewel** is a beautiful, shiny stone that costs a lot of money. Diamonds and emeralds are **jewels**.

jewellery

Rings, necklaces and earrings are **jewellery**. **Jewellery** is often made of gold or silver, sometimes with jewels.

jigsaw jigsaws

A **jigsaw** is a puzzle. You fit together shapes to make a picture.

This jigsaw has 100 pieces.



job jobs

1 A **job** is something you have to do.
It's my job to collect the books.

2 A **job** is also work that you are paid to do.

My mum has a job as a bus driver.
