# THE FROST DRAGON

Of all the Viking dragons, the Frost Dragon is one of the most unusual species. While most dragons are able to breathe fire, the Frost Dragon possesses a peculiar ability to breathe out an icy frost, freezing everything and anyone in its path.



### APPEARANCE

The Frost Dragon is easily identified by the sharp icicles that line its spine and tail. Like most dragon species, it has huge wings, large jaws and a long, powerful tail. However, this dragon also has pale blue, scaly skin that is freezing cold to the touch. Females often possess an added silver shimmer along the centre of their backs.

### HABITAT

Frost Dragons live in large groups. It is vital that they keep their body temperatures cool, particularly during the summer. They hide in the coldest and darkest corners of caves, and only their silvery shimmer helps them to identify one another in the darkness. They can also reside in glacial caves, where temperatures are even cooler.

### CHARACTER

Unlike the majority of dragon species, the Frost Dragon is most active during the winter and falls into its Sleep Coma during the warmer months. Experts believe that, because of its ice-breathing abilities and opposite hibernation patterns, it considers itself to be a separate species altogether.
