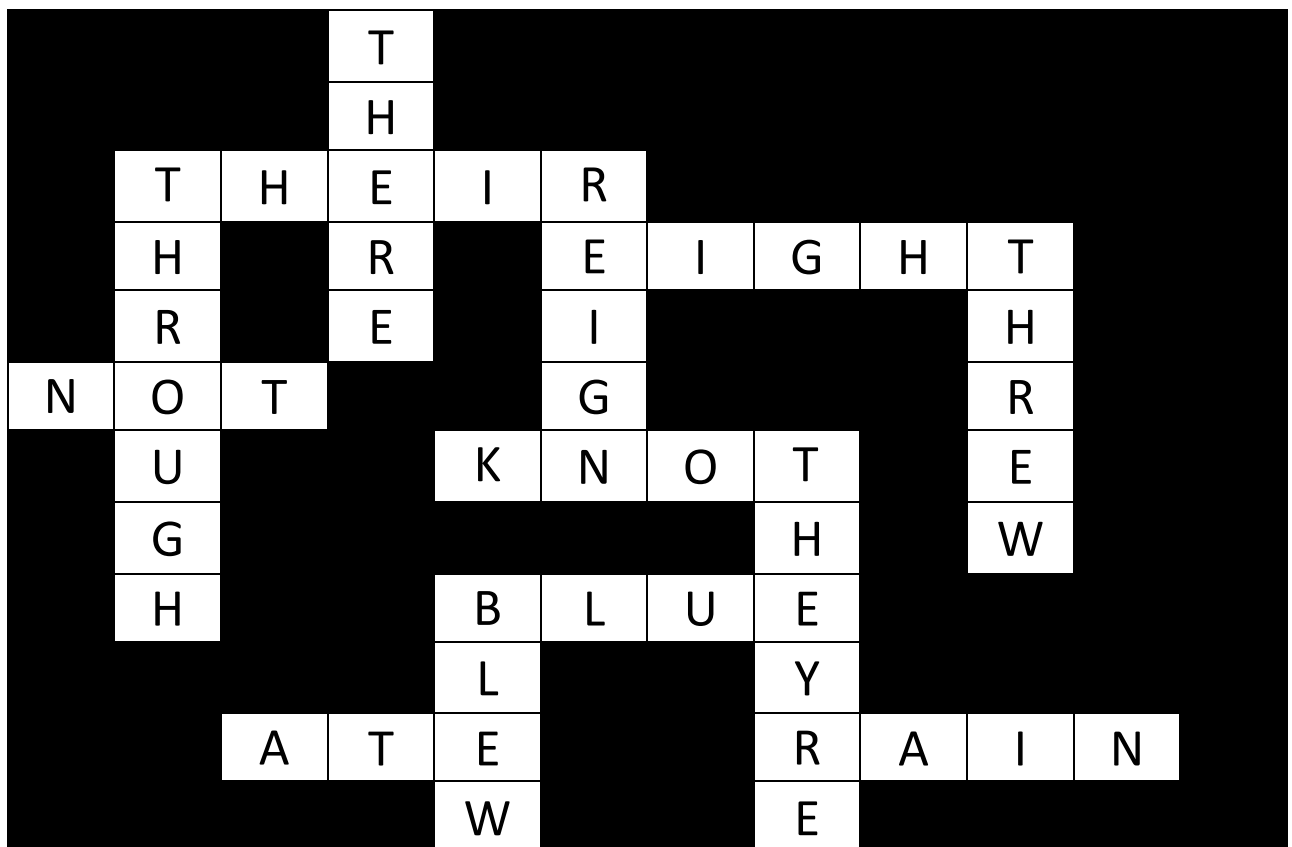


To use a range of homophones correctly (Activity 2)
