- 5. The text ends with "The entire wood seemed to explode around him". What do you think happened?
- 6. The author uses the simile "Quick as a whip" to describe how quickly Mr Fox jumped back into his hole. Write another simile that could have been used to describe how quickly he moved.
- 7. In your own words, explain what is meant by the following phrases that appear in the text:
 - a. smelled out
 - b. mouth of the hole
 - c. his ears pricked
- 8. Explain and describe how Mr Fox comes out of his hole. Number each step.
