Part One - Ancient Greek Timeline

- ✓ Write a short paragraph about one of the key events from the timeline (either using the information pack or through research with an adult)

- ✓ Read the Part 2 Information Pack about Everyday Life in Ancient Greece
- ✓ Choose one of the following tasks:
 - Create a **fact file** with a section about each of the key roles **OR**
 - Write a **diary entry** imagining that you are one of those key roles.

Part Three - Artwork Showing Ancient Greece

- ✓ Produce a piece of artwork showing an event from your **Ancient Greek Timeline**.
