Task:

Over the next four weeks you will be asked to independently research the life of a famous person who lived during the Victorian era. Each week you will be given a focus for your research and you will be asked to produce *a minimum of two handwritten A4 sides*. If you would like to include pictures/diagrams photocopied from books or downloaded from the Internet, you may do so but you must reference where you got them from. (Underneath the picture write the name of the website or book.)

Each week you should think about the most appropriate way of presenting your research. You could use:

- Bullet point lists
- Fact Boxes
- Drawings/cartoons
- Diagrams
- Maps
- Quizzes
- Charts.

In the final week you will be asked to produce a title page, index and bibliography(a list of all the books/websites you used) for your project which will then be stuck into your Victorian project book at school.

Choose someone well know during the Victorian Era as the subject for your biography (see attached sheet for some examples)

Produce *two A4 sides of hand written work* about the childhood and early life of your chosen person. Think about including:

- Details about where and when they were born
- Information about who their parents were and what they did
