

In the Bible, God has many different names. He is one God but has different titles given to him and these titles describe parts of his character.

This is like you being called son/daughter, brother/sister, friend, peer... and would be like us describing you based on what your character is like, for example friendly, caring, sporty, artistic, creative, kind, funny etc.




Understanding the Holy Trinity

The Bible is made up of 66 books, split into 2 parts - the Old Testament (39 books) and the New Testament (27 books).

The Old Testament is written before Jesus was born and the New Testament has accounts of Jesus' life and death and then is all about the early Christian Church.

We're going to have a look at 4 names that God was given in the Old Testament.



Can you match these 4 names of God with what you think they mean?


Elohim God Almighty
