- ✓ Use capital letters for the starts of new lines.

- 1. Read through your draft carefully. Can you correct any mistakes or make any improvements?
- 2. Write the final version of your rhyming poem in your neatest handwriting so that it's easy to read.
- 3. You could perform your poem to your adult at home and impress them with your newly developed rhyming skills!
