In RE, we have been looking at the importance of prayer to Christians. **Prayer** is communicating with God. Christians may choose to do this using **set prayers** or **informal prayer**. This may be demonstrated in silence or aloud, singing or crying, with others or alone. Sometimes Christians say a **set prayer** before eating a meal to thank God for providing what they need to live. Other Christians might pray spontaneously for their meal using their own words, in an **informal prayer**.

The Lord's prayer begins by making it clear who people are praying to. Christians believe that God is the Father of everyone. God wants Christians to talk to him like we talk to our own father. God is Christian's loving father and he considers us all as his special children.

Christians believe that god will answer **prayer** but not always in the way the person would like. Some Christians use the Lord's Prayer (known as a set prayer) to help them with opening a conversation with God.

Our Father, who art in heaven
Hallowed be thy name
Thy kingdom come
Thy will be done
On earth as it is in heaven
Give us this day our daily bread
And forgive us our trespasses
As we forgive those who trespass against us
And lead us not into temptation
But deliver us from evil
