1 Planet 3: Mars

- 2 Mars is the planet which is most like Earth. It has volcanoes, deserts and ice. However, Mars is further from the Sun and is much colder than Earth. There are lots of storms on Mars.
- 4 Mars is about half the size of Earth, but has the same amount of dry land because there is no liquid water on Mars.
- 6 We don't know if there was ever life on Mars.

7 Planet 4: Jupiter

- 8 Jupiter is the biggest of all the planets. It is so big that all of the other planets could fit inside it. Jupiter is mostly made of gas, although there is some liquid. It does not have solid land that you could stand on.
- 11 The planets Saturn, Uranus and Neptune are even further from the Sun. They are too cold for you to go to.

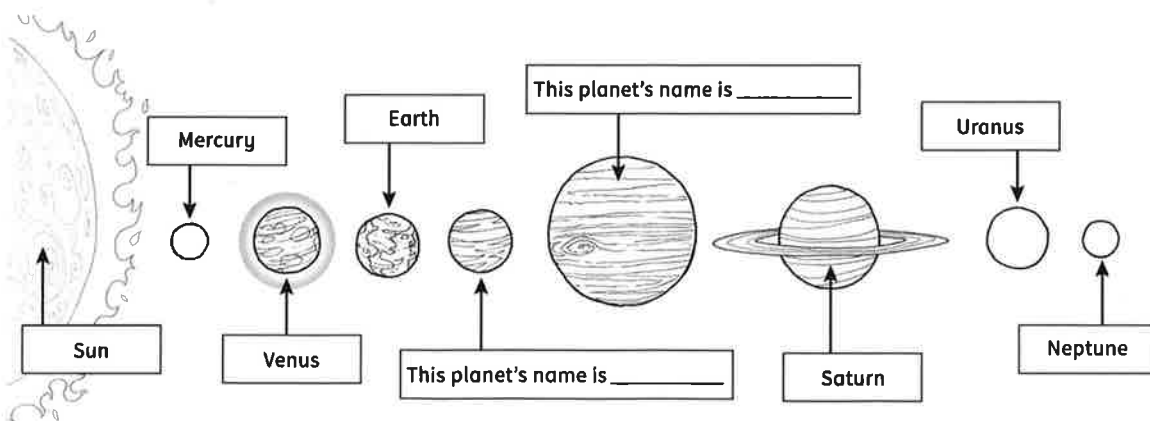
