Task Two: Write a letter to stop the building of a motorway through local woodland

Now, imagine that the government has decided to build a huge motorway which runs straight through a local woodland called 'Butter Woods"!

It is your job to write a letter to the local council detailing all of the reasons why you believe that this should not happen. You should use the research you did in Task one to help you write this letter and think about the following points:

- ✓ What wildlife might live in Butter Woods?
- \checkmark Why is the forest an important habitat to preserve?
- \checkmark What would happen if the habitat was not protected?
- \checkmark Why the animals and plants are important to preserve?
- ✓ Which people use the space?

Once you have thought about all of these ideas, I want you to think about how we could write a letter to the council highlighting why you believe that the forest should be saved.

Your letter should include:

- > Introduction: Explain who you are and briefly explain of why you are writing.
- > 1st paragraph: Describe why Butter Wood is an important habitat.
- > 2nd **Paragraph**: Explain what would happen if the motorway was built.
- Conclusion: Justify why the motorway would be a bad idea and what they could do instead.
