



SCIENCE: MIGRATING JOURNEYS

- Activity 1: Watch the journey of a humpback whale video and make notes. Once you have watched the clip, complete the true or false quiz (you will need to pause the video, decide on your answers and then resume the video to see the answers).
- Activity 2: Research at least 2 animals of your choice that make an 'incredible journey' during their life cycle. You might want to choose from the following: swift, osprey, wildebeest, blue whale, salamander. Alternatively, you can select your own animals.

- Activity 3: Create a fact file highlighting the main points from your research. Try to include the following information: the type of animal, how far it travels as it migrates, where it starts its journey, where it ends its journey, the size of the animal and its life expectancy (how long they usually live).
- Activity 4: Using a map of the world, plot the incredible journeys made by the animals you have researched this week. You could include photos or illustrations to bring their journey to life and highlight the amazing places or experiences they meet along the way.
- Activity 5: Create your own 'incredible journey'. This could be a journey you have already made (maybe one that you go on every year) or it could be a journey you would like to make. Be imaginative – you can go anywhere you like! Present your ideas in your favourite way – collage, film, documentary, story board – the choice is yours! Be sure to explain why you would make this journey and the impact it would have on your life.
