Year 3 Summer Term Activities 2024

This term the children in Year 3 will be involved in the following activities:

RHS Wisley

As part of the Year 3 Science Topic on plants we have arranged a visit to RHS Wisley. The day will include a hands-on workshop examining the parts of a plant and how seeds are dispersed. The visit will take place on

Thursday 11th July

We will be travelling by coach; the children should be in school by 8.40am as usual and they will be back by the end of the school day at 3.30pm.

The children will need a packed lunch, children who usually have a school lunch can either have a packed meal provided by the school kitchen or bring one from home – please indicate their preference on the consent form on ParentPay.

St Thomas-on-the-Bourne C of E Church

Year 3 will be visiting St Thomas-on-the-Bourne C of E Church as part of our study of how the Christian faith is expressed. We will be looking at how the church is a hub for a range of activities all through the week for Christians, as well as the role of services in the local parish life. The children will also get to see how a church is laid out, we will be discussing religious symbols and how the church is used for worship and prayer. The visit will take place **Wednesday 22nd May**.

We would also be grateful if anyone would be able to help with supervision on each of the trips. All volunteers need to have an Enhanced DBS which has been arranged or verified by our School Office.

Ancient Greek Workshop

In addition, on **Thursday 9th May** there will be an Ancient Greek Workshop where the children will learn about the sunny land of myths and legends but also the cradle of theatre, music, politics, and poetry. The children will have an opportunity to explore Ancient Greek life through dance, song, and art.
